Registration for 2010-2011 will continue through the Spring. After registration opened last week, over 50 students have been enrolled for the 2010-2011 school year! Please help us by registering as soon as possible and also help recruit new families to OLOL. There are rewards for bringing a new family to OLOL as well as just having them take a tour. Our goal with the bus program at St. Frances Cabrini Parish and our new preschool is to have 140 students enrolled for the 2010-2011 school year. If you will need financial assistance, please apply through the sources we offer: Schmitz Family Foundation and Parish Assistance if you qualify. The registration fee will be \$150 per family. Tuition has been set at \$4,000 for affiliated and \$5,000 for non-affiliated. After the tuition papers have been completed, Mrs. Crandell will send home the school registration forms for the 2010-2011 school year. Thank you in advance for all your support!
